When I think about Christianity in the marketplace of ideas, it stands out for a variety of reasons. One of those is God's faithfulness. Repeatedly, God makes claims in the Bible that we see come to fruition. Some are seeminaly small, others are massive. Last month we celebrated Jesus, who he is and what he has done for us on the cross at Easter. This is obviously central to Christianity and is also a precursor to another fulfilled promise. While Jesus is reclining at the table in the Upper Room with his disciples the night before being handed over to the Jewish religious leaders by Judas, he tells them that he will send the Holy Spirit to guide, direct and comfort them. Jump ahead roughly 7 weeks and we see the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost in Acts 2. Jesus may no longer be present with his followers, but his Spirit now dwells within them and empowers them to live out the life they were created for. This act of God's faithfulness is the same for Jesus' followers in the here and now. We have his Spirit dwelling within us, empowering us to live out the Christian life. May this bring you comfort. May it give you boldness as you make Jesus known. May it help you to faithfully follow Jesus in all he has called you to. Pastor Zach
