In light of the devastating earthquake in **Haiti**, here are a few ways you can help relief efforts. Donations to eligible Canadian charities from January 12-February 12, 2010 will be matched by the Government of Canada, up to \$50 million.

- Donate \$5 via the Salvation Army by texting the word "Haiti" to 45678. The money will be charged to your next cell phone bill.
- Visit www.cmalliance.ca to learn how to donate through our National Ministry Centre. We can also forward your donation to the Centre if you make your cheque out to Sevenoaks Alliance Church and designate 'Global Emergency Response Fund' in the memo line.
- Bring non-perishable food to the Food Bank. Abbotsford Vineyard Church has worked with Heart to Heart Ministries in Haiti for five years and is shipping several containers of food. Money donations are also needed. For more info, email John with Heart to Heart at john-neufeld-h2h@shaw.ca.
